I thought there was something under the Advanced Options to clip an audio or video file while converting it, but I cannot find this option where I remember it. Was it there and got removed, or am I confusing this with something else?

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Yes. If you choose a sound input format, the Conversion Options box will show you the "split" option. You enable it and after the upload of your MIDI file you will have an interface to listen and cut the song (start and end time)
